Ground Rules

Access and/or presence, for whatever reason, within the sports facility during football matches, is governed by the "Ground Rules". Non-compliance with the Ground Rules will result in the immediate termination of the performance contract, along with the removal of the offender from the facility, and the application of provisions and sanctions as per current regulations, including the application of access bans to locations where sports events take place (DASPO).

Access and/or presence within the sports facility is also subject to compliance with the behavioral rules outlined in the ethical code adopted by the Sports Society, the effects of which are finalized upon the acquisition, for whatever reason, of the ticket.

1. In particular, the following provisions are emphasized:

- a. The stadium access ticket/pass is personal and may not be transferred to third parties, except in cases and according to the methods provided by the national legislation and the club.
- b. To access the stadium, possession of a valid identification document is required, which must also be shown upon request by the stewards to verify the correspondence between the ticket/pass holder and the bearer.
- c. The access ticket/pass must be kept until leaving the stadium.
- d. Access through vehicles in the designated parking and parking areas is regulated by specifically authorized passes (so-called car passes).
- e. The spectator has the right and duty to occupy the assigned seat, and therefore, by purchasing the tickets, undertakes not to occupy different seats, even if they are not used by other individuals, unless expressly authorized by the organizing Society upon authorization from the competent authorities.
- f. The spectator may be subjected to checks, including those carried out by stewards and by means of metal detectors, aimed at preventing the introduction of illegal, prohibited, and/or dangerous materials, and is obliged to follow the instructions provided by the stewards.

2. Inside the sports facility and the reserved external area, it is FORBIDDEN to:

- a. Express any form of racial, ethnic, or religious discrimination or other manifestations of intolerance with chants or the display of signs.
- b. Stand near passages, stairways, exits, entrances, along access routes, exit routes, and any other escape routes without a justifiable reason.
- c. Climb on balustrades, parapets, dividers, and other structures not specifically designated for the public's use.
- d. Damage or tamper with structures, infrastructures, and services of the facility in any way.
- e. Introduce or possess poisons, harmful substances, flammable or staining materials, and drugs.

- f. Introduce or sell alcoholic beverages with an alcohol content higher than 5°, except with authorizations and/or exceptions for specific areas, issued by the G.O.S., subject to the favorable opinion of the Questore (local police chief). In addition, it is clarified that in "hospitality areas," the administration of alcoholic beverages up to 21° is allowed with the required administrative authorizations from the competent authorities, subject to specific directives from the G.O.S. and with the favorable opinion of the Questore.
- g. Introduce or possess stones, knives, objects intended to offend or capable of being thrown, systems for emitting light rays (laser pointers), and other objects that may cause disturbance or danger to the safety of all individuals present in the facility.
- h. Introduce belts with large metal buckles and other accessories or aids that may pose a safety risk to the event.
- i. Introduce umbrellas, except for small-sized ones that do not have sharp points and are made of materials that do not pose a safety risk to the event and the spectators.
- j. Introduce crutches, except with explicit authorizations.
- k. Display material that obstructs the view of other fans or emergency signage or that otherwise obstructs escape routes to the playing field.
- l. Engage in any kind of commercial activity that has not been previously authorized.
- m. Introduce and sell within the sports facility beverages contained in cans, glass or plastic bottles.
- n. Introduce animals of any kind, except with explicit authorizations.
- o. Introduce and/or wear vests or clothing of the same or similar color and style as those worn by stewards and other service personnel.
- p. Introduce and/or display banners, signs, horizontal banners, pennants, documents, drawings, printed or written material, sound instruments not explicitly authorized by the Security Operations Group (G.O.S.) upon the request of the Sports Society, following the procedures outlined in the subsequent point 3. In this case, the aforementioned materials must only be placed in areas designated by the Organizer and removed at the end of the sports event.
- q. Organize choreographies that are not authorized or that deviate from those authorized by the Security Operations Group (GOS) upon the request of the Organizer, following the procedures outlined in the subsequent point 3.
- r. Enter and remain within the facility while intoxicated or under the influence of narcotics or psychotropic substances. It is worth noting that the following behaviors, in addition to being subject to administrative sanctions as violations of these regulations, may also constitute criminal offenses: disguise, possession of weapons, the display of emblems or symbols of associations that promote discrimination or violence based on racial, ethnic, national, or religious reasons, incitement to violence during competitive events, possession, throwing, and the use of dangerous materials and pyrotechnic devices, crossing barriers, and invading the playing field.

3. Within the sports facility and the reserved external area, subject to authorization from the Security Operations Group (G.O.S.), it is PERMITTED to introduce and/or display banners, signs, horizontal banners, pennants, documents, drawings, printed or written material, megaphones, and drums with a single beat, as well as to organize choreographies, provided that they are expressly authorized by the Security Operations Group (G.O.S.), following this procedure. Requests related to the introduction of the mentioned material and

the organization of choreographies must be submitted exclusively to the sports society in accordance with sector directives, indicating the identifying information of the contacts and individual users. The Supporter Liaison Officer (S.L.O), after performing the necessary checks, will request authorization from the G.O.S. All materials must be displayed only in designated and authorized areas and must be removed at the end of the event. Finally, it is noted that the stadium is monitored by an audio-video recording system positioned both inside and outside, and the data is processed by the stadium owner in accordance with the provisions of Legislative Decree 196/2003, D.M. 06/06/2005, and Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The processing of personal data is carried out in compliance with legal regulations.
